Contents and Instructions

Heavyocity's *Free Production Loops* were built entirely from the award-winning virtual instruments, *AEON Collection* & *DM-307: Modern Groove Designer*.

AEON Collection is a cinematic standard -- packed with over 27 GB of organic and synth Melodic Instruments, cutting-edge Loops, Arpeggiated Instruments, and Epic One-Shots. Since its release, AEON has been awarded a number of industry accolades, including Electronic Musician's Editor's Choice Award.

*DM-307* has been equally acclaimed, adding MusicTech's Gear of the Year and another EM Editor's Choice Award to the Heavyocity trophy case. A highly-stylized collection of modular synth drums, live percussion, and classic analog drum machines, *DM-307* delivers a dynamic and versatile percussion library, perfect for your next composition.

## INSTALLATION

- 1. Download and install the Continuata downloader tool from your download email.
- 2. Open Continuata and enter the serial included in your download email. Select a destination and initiate download.
- 3. Once downloaded, browse the different folders for the desired format (REX, WAV or Apple Loops) according to your DAW of choice.
- 4. Experience the sound of AEON and DM-307!

## CONTENT

The total loop content for the pack corresponds to 60 melodic loops created with the **AEON Collection**, and 259 percussive loops created with **DM-307 Modern Groove Designer**, presented in *REX, WAV and Apple Loops* format. *AEON* Loops cover a wide range of melodic sequences crafted with synthetic and organic sounds, producing a signature sound aligned with modern film scoring trends. *DM-307* Loops offer a variety of Industrial and Hybrid Cinematic grooves, ready to add powerful cinematic rhythms and effects to any production.

Each audio file is seamlessly looped and formatted for the various file types, in order to achieve maximum flexibility and usability. Each file details the **name of the loop** and the **tempo where it sounds the best**. For *AEON* loops, the file also includes the **root key it was created in**. For the *DM-307* loops, the file name details the kind of stem it is (Cymbals/FX, Snare, Kick Drum, etc.) or if it is the full loop (all stems together).
